Young Professionals is a challenging programme which offers ambitious and high-achieving students an insight into different future career paths. Students receive both theoretical and practical tuition in one of five possible professions:

- Art & Design
- Business
- Forensic Science & Criminology
- International Relations & Law
- Performing Arts

Young Professionals receive a variety of teaching styles, combining theory lessons, practical sessions and group project work, as well as academic skills lessons designed to improve personal qualities such as critical thinking, logic and interview technics. Each week, students go on a "Study-in-Action" excursion, to a destination related to their chosen career.

Tonbridge School was first established in 1553 by Sir Andrew Judde and King Edward VI. Today, Tonbridge is one of the most highly-regarded and exclusive boarding schools in the country and forms part of the 'Eton Group' of schools.

Classes are taught with a maximum size of 11 students, ensuring students are always engaged and receive ample attention from tutors.

Academic hours consist of the following per week:

9 hours subject theory (classroom-based in the mornings).

6 hours subject practicals (workshop-based teaching in the afternoons)

7 hours group project work (subject-based)

3 hours of skills electives

Subjects are most enjoyed when students have the opportunity to get out of their chairs and experience their chosen areas first-hand.

These afternoon periods will allow students to truly understand their selected subjects, whether it be in the laboratory (forensic science), pitching mock-business plans (business) or creating a production (performing arts).

Art & Design

Through classroom study and practical studio sessions, students are made aware of both traditional and new media. Guided through a range of relevant images, artefacts and resources relating to art, craft and design, from the past and from recent times, including European and non-European examples. This should be integral to the investigating, inspiration and creative processes. The course will build their understanding of different styles, genres and traditions.

It is aimed for students wishing to explore a future in the creative industry. Success will measured by students who have a good eye or detail, creative flair and the ability to bring their ideas to life.

Business

Students will learn to evaluate business behaviour from the perspective of a range of stakeholders including owner, shareholder, manager, employee, customer, supplier, lender and government.

It is aimed for students who want to get a head start in the business world and develop their understanding of how success is built within the world of work.

Forensic Science & Criminology

Students enrolled on this courses explore elements from a multitude of fields such as chemistry, biology, physics, geology, psychology and social science. Forensic science teaches students to be methodical, accurate, unbiased and openminded. A combination of laboratory-based experiments, case studies and anatomical studies provides students with an intriguing first step into the field.

It is aimed for inquisitive students who have a broad interest in the field of science and human psychology. The course is ideal for students interested in an investigative career in government or private industry.

International Relations & Law

This course offers a study of world history, global power relations and shifts in the international economy. The syllabus aims to enhance student knowledge on the sources of conflict and cooperation among states, as well as the roles of culture, identity and ideas in world politics.

It is aimed for students who pretend careers in global organisations such as government foreign offices, the United Nations or the European. International relations can also be applied at roles in overseas aid, international development and NGOs.

Performing Arts

Train like a West End professional with London theatre workshops covering audition techniques, musical choreography and bringing a script to life, the course offers a fantastic opportunity to train with West End cast members and learn more about world famous West End theatre.

It is aimed for students interested in pursuing a career in the arts, those with a passion for acting and screen writing, as well as those looking to improve their expressive skills and confidence.


