Sat 11 Jul	Buckingham Palace (Cultural) One of the most iconic places in London, Buckingham Palace is the residence and headquarters of the reigning monarch. A must see destination when visiting London.
Sat 18 Jul	The London Bridge Experience (Cultural) Located within the vaults of the original 1831 bridge, The London Bridge Experience traces the 2000 year history of the world's most famous and haunted bridge. Take a trip into the Bridge's history and spooky haunted tunnels, as you encounter different characters, tear down the old Viking Bridge and meet the Keeper of the Heads.
Sat 25 Jul	Natural History Museum and Wildlife Garden (Cultural) Discover the natural world, its past, present and future and take a look at the magnificent specimens on show. From workshops, science shows to self-led activities, the museum is a world-class visitor attraction and a leading research centre.
Sat 1 Aug	Hampton Court Palace (Cultural) Explore Henry VIII's majestic palace, including his magnificent state apartments and vast Tudor kitchens. Don't miss the Haunted Gallery, the Baroque Palace, the formal gardens and the famous maze.
Sat 8 Aug	Legoland (Recreational) A child-friendly theme park allows the students to have a fully interactive and fun experience. With over 55 rides and attractions from riding the rapids to the Atlantis Submarine Voyage.

All Saturdays	Central London (Sightseeing) A walking tour of London, viewing the city's most iconic sites such as Big Ben, Buckingham Palace and Westminster. A chance to walk through the heart of the capital and take pictures that will stay with you for ever.

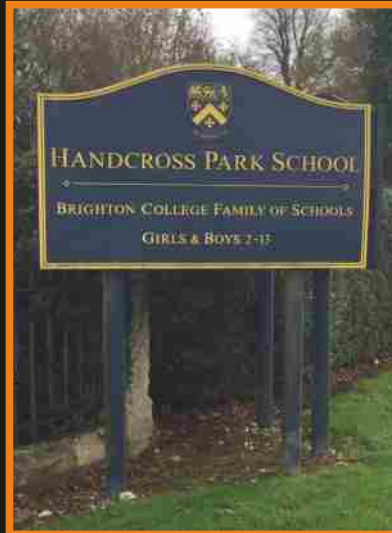
